

The Supplement to the Workshop Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Freehold was held on Monday, September 20, 2010 at 7:00 PM in the Municipal Building.

Councilman Kane offered a motion to accept the minutes from the Regular Meeting September 7, 2010, seconded by Councilman DiBenedetto.

On roll call Council Members DiBenedetto, Kane, Newman, Schnurr, Shutzer and Sims voted its adoption; opposed none; abstain none; absent none. Council President Sims declared the motion adopted.

Council President Sims read Item No. 5 on the Agenda as follows:

“Second Reading and Public Hearing: Ordinance #2010/15 Amending Chapter 8 Garbage, Trash and Refuse Collection and Disposal of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Freehold.”

Council President Sims opened the meeting to the public.

Robert Taylor, 13 Kiawah Avenue, asked what was being changed in this ordinance.

Ms. Higgins, Borough Attorney, explained stormwater regulations were changed by the State and every town has to adopt an ordinance when the regulations change. She explained that all refuse must be in a sealed container and no trash containers or dumpsters should have holes on the bottom because it could cause leakage into the storm sewers.

Mr. Bellina stated that he would see no change on a day to day basis.

Councilwoman Shutzer stated the ordinance has to do with what cannot be allowed to get into the stormwater drains.

Councilman Kane offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Councilman DiBenedetto:

RESOLUTION TO CLOSE PUBLIC PORTION.

On roll call Council Members DiBenedetto, Kane, Newman, Schnurr, Shutzer and Sims voted its adoption; opposed none; abstain none; absent none. Council President Sims declared the motion adopted.

Councilwoman Shutzer offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Councilman DiBenedetto:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Freehold that an Ordinance entitled “ORDINANCE #2010/15 AMENDING CHAPTER 8 GARBAGE, TRASH AND REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEHOLD”, be, and same is hereby adopted on second reading.

On roll call Council Members DiBenedetto, Kane, Newman, Schnurr, Shutzer and Sims voted its adoption; opposed none; abstain none; absent none. Council President Sims declared the motion adopted.

Council President Sims read Item No. 6 on the Agenda as follows:

“Introduction and Authorization to Publish Ordinance #2010/16 of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Freehold, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey Authorizing the Acceptance of the Orchard Street Pump Station Block 84 Lot 65.08.”

Councilman DiBenedetto offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Councilman Kane:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Freehold that an Ordinance entitled “ORDINANCE #2010/16 OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEHOLD, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE ORCHARD STREET PUMP STATION BLOCK 84, LOT 65.08” be, and same is hereby approved on first reading; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk be and she is hereby authorized to publish said Ordinance in the Asbury Park Press and that same shall be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting held on October 4, 2010 and that during the week of said meeting copies of the Ordinance shall be made available at the Clerk’s office to members of the general public who shall request same.

Kerry Higgins stated the Orchard Street development was approved in 2006 and they were required to build a pump station. The deed to this pump station was never recorded and it needs to be formally accepted before we can take control over it.

On roll call Council Members DiBenedetto, Kane, Newman, Schnurr, Shutzer and Sims voted its adoption; opposed none; abstain none; absent none. Council President Sims declared the motion adopted.

Council President Sims read Item No. 7 on the Agenda as follows:
