ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) AND
CHAPTER 12 (STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES), OF THE
REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF FREEHOLD**

BE IT ORDAINED that Chapter 10 (Vehicles and Traffic) be amended as follows:

SECTION 1

Chapter 10.08 Traffic Regulations shall be amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 10.08.020 One-Way Streets

a. The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule VII set out in Chapter 10,44 are designated as one-way streets in the direction indicated.

b. Any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) for each violation.

Chapter 10.08.070 Entrances and Exits

10.08.070 b. Violation – Penalty

Any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) for each violation.

Chapter 10.16 Handicapped Parking

10.16.040 Handicapped identification required for vehicle.

B. Violation – Penalty

Any person who shall be guilty of a violation of any of the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for the first offense. Any

person who shall be guilty of a second or subsequent offense shall be subject to a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100) for each subsequent violation.

Chapter 10.20 Public Parking Lots

10.20.030 H. Violation – Penalty

Any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for each violation.

10.20.040 Broad and West Main Street Parking Lot Regulations

10.20.040 S. Violation – Penalty

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for each violation.

10.20.050 Court and Broad Street Parking Lot Regulations

10.20.040 Q. Violation – Penalty

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for each violation.

10.20.060 Removal of vehicles

10.20.060 b.. Violation – Penalty

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) for each violation.

Chapter 10.24 Permit Parking Areas

10.24.040 Use of Permits

10.24.040 D. Violation – Penalty

Any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for each violation.

Chapter 10.28 Permit Parking

10.28.020 D. Violation – Penalty

Any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for each violation.

Chapter 10.29 Permit Parking

10.29.020 D. Violation – Penalty

Any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for each violation.

Chapter 12 Streets, Sidewalks and Public Places

12.20 Snow and Ice Removal

12.20.010 D. Violation – Penalty

Any person who shall be guilty of a violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) for each violation.

SECTION 2

If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3

Any Ordinance or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and superseded.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with Law.
